Municipalities in 2015 with unpaid obligations and with fewer revenues from property tax

NGO EC Ma Ndryshe has published the infographics regarding the budget performance of the municipalities that it monitors.

Budget data includes the progress on capital spending, revenues from property tax and unpaid obligations for the municipalities of Prishtina, Prizren, Peja, Mitrovica, Gjilan, Ferizaj and Gjakova, as well as for municipalities of Suhareka, Rahovec, Malisheva, Dragash, Mamusha and Shtrpce.

The data presented in infographics were obtained from the annual financial report of 2015 of the Ministry of Finance of the Republic of Kosovo.

NGO "Ec Ma Ndryshe" started implementing the project "Municipal Transparency Index Reform" since May 2015, thanks to the support of the British Embassy in Prishtina, which covers the largest municipalities of Kosovo such as Prishtina, Prizren, Peja, Mitrovica, Gjilan, Ferizaj and Gjakova, as well as Suhareka, Rahovec, Malisheva, Dragash, Mamusha and Shtrpce. Transparency Index presents a structured effort to support Kosovo municipalities in meeting the standards of good governance, defined with the reform of local government and Kosovo's European agenda.
